Rooted in the sacred Pandharpur tradition of Maharashtra, Mauli explores the spiritual legacy of Panduranga-Vittala through scholarship-driven choreography and evocative storytelling. Drawing from bhakti poetry, ritual practices and classical aesthetics, the Bharatanatyam work reflects centuries of devotion that continue to shape faith and artistic expression.

Through refined movement vocabulary and layered narratives, Chandrashekar brings alive the emotional world of the Varkari tradition, presenting devotion not only as ritual but as lived experience. The performance seeks to connect audiences with the philosophical depth and enduring relevance of this bhakti heritage.

Presented by Aayam Institute as part of its ongoing commitment to classical arts, Mauli offers Delhi audiences an immersive encounter with a sacred tradition that has inspired generations.
